FSC MEMBERSHIP ENGAGEMENT OPPORTUNITIES 2022

DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE

7 Global membership meetings (Feb-May)

Attended by global membership and some FSC staff. Purpose is to **discuss the 15 policy motions prioritized for discussion** and **9 statutory motions**. Motion proposers will present their motions, and a staff member will give a feasibility analysis. Members provide feedback to help motion proposer to improve their motions.

Motions discussion groups for selected topics (March-August)

Small focused discussion groups comprised of 6-12 people which may include: Motion Proposer and/or seconders, FSC Staff Member, Board Member, BGC, MC. Purpose is to **discuss the quality of motions, suggest improvements** and/or identify opportunity for **merging** of similar or related motions.

4 Global cross-chamber dialogues (June-July)

Cross-chamber discussions for members in each chamber to provide feedback on the 54 motions to the motion proposers. Chambers will **identify the strengths, concerns and actions required to improve the motions** as well as **define their general chamber position** on the motions.

5 Regional membership meetings (June-July)

Members in each region engage on topics related to **preparing for the GA**, as well as other **challenges and opportunities in their region**.

Self organized membership engagement (March-August)

Membership team will support motion proposers with the **organization of informal spaces** for discussion between motion proposers and members, providing several **platforms** and **tools**. Motion proposers can use tools to **engage, promote, negotiate and discuss final amendments to the motions**.

4 Global chamber meetings (September)

Each global chamber to discuss **the motions that will be presented to the GA for voting**. Opportunity to **gather new points of view** from within the chamber for each motion and **identify the chamber priority policy motions for voting** at the GA.
